

Privacy Policy

Tax From US online nonresident tax preparation software has been designed, developed and is fully owned by Tax From US LLC.

This privacy policy has been created to better serve those who are concerned about how their 'Personally identifiable information' (PII) is being used online. PII, as used in US privacy law and information security, is information that can be used on its own or with other information to identify, contact, or locate a single person, or to identify an individual in context. Please read our privacy policy carefully to get a clear understanding of how we collect, use, protect or otherwise handle your Personally Identifiable Information in accordance with our website.

What personal information do we collect?

When registering on our site, you may be asked to enter your name, email address, mailing address, phone number, financial information, social security number or equivalent and other details necessary to file a tax return on your behalf.

When do we collect information?

We collect information from you when you register on our site, respond to a survey, fill out a form or enter information on our site.

How do we use your information?

We may use the information we collect from you when you register, make a purchase, sign up for our newsletter, respond to a survey or marketing communication, surf the website, or use certain other site features in the following ways:

- To personalize user's experience and to allow us to deliver the type of content and product offerings in which you are most interested.
- To improve our website in order to better serve you.
- To allow us to better service you in responding to your customer service requests.
- To quickly process your transactions.

We will never sell your information.

How do we protect visitor's information?

Our website is scanned on a regular basis for security holes and known vulnerabilities in order to make your visit to our site as safe as possible.

We use regular Malware Scanning.

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive/credit information you provide is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

All transactions are processed through a gateway provider and are not stored or processed on our servers.

We implement a variety of security measures when a user places an order, enters, submits, or accesses his information to maintain the safety of your personal information. However, we cannot provide method of storing your information with 100% security, as such we cannot guarantee its absolute security. If you have any questions about security on our website, please contact us as outlined below.

Do we use 'cookies'?

Yes. Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the site's or service provider's systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information. For instance, we use cookies to help us to monitor progress of your tax return. They are also used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services. We also use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future.

We use cookies to:

- Help us to monitor progress of your tax return.
- Understand and save user's preferences for future visits.
 - Keep track of advertisements.
 - Compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interactions in order to offer better site experiences and tools in the future. We may also use trusted third party services that track this information on our behalf.

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your browser (like Internet Explorer) settings. Each browser is a little bit different, so look at your browser's Help menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies.

If users disable cookies in their browser:

If you disable cookies, some features will be disabled. It will turn off some of the features that make your site experience more efficient and some of our services will not function properly.

However, you can still fill and file your taxes.

Third Party Disclosure

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties your personally identifiable information unless we provide you with advance notice. This does not include website hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you, as long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others' rights, property, or safety.

If Tax From US is involved in merger, acquisition or sale of all or part of its assets, you will be notified via email and/or notice on our website of any change in ownership.

Information obtained from Third Parties

If you provide us with personal information about others, or if others give us your information, we will use that information solely for the specific reason for which it was given to us.

Refer-A-Friend

If you choose to refer a friend to us through one of our referral programs, we will ask you for your friend's name and email address. We will automatically send your friend an email inviting him or her to visit the site. Tax From US retains this information for the sole purpose of sending this once-off email and tracking the success of our referral program.

As it is the case with most websites, we automatically gather information about your computer such as your IP address, browser type, referring / exit pages, and operating system

Fair Information Practices

The Fair Information Practices Principles form the backbone of privacy law in the United States and the concepts they include have played a significant role in the development of data protection laws around the globe. Understanding the Fair Information Practice Principles and how they should be implemented is critical to comply with the various privacy laws that protect personal information.

In order to be in line with Fair Information Practices, we will take the following responsive action, should a data breach occur:

We will notify the users via email

- Within 7 business days

We will notify the users via in site notification

- Within 7 business days

We also agree to the individual redress principle, which requires that individuals have a right to pursue legally enforceable rights against data collectors and processors who fail to adhere to the law. This principle requires not only that individuals have enforceable rights against data users, but also that individuals have recourse to courts or a government agency to investigate and/or prosecute non-

compliance by data processors.
